### Brownsville Clean-up Day October 3rd, 2020

Sweet Home Sanitation will be holding the annual Brownsville Clean-up day, Saturday October 3rd from 7:30am-3:00pm on Park Avenue between City Hall and the Rec Center. The event is for Brownsville residents only and proof of residence is required. Please bring drivers license or garbage bill for proof of residency.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions residents will need to sort and place their items into the appropriate bins. Sweet Home Sanitation staff will not be able to assist you due to these requirements. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause!

### Acceptable Items:

- Old Lumber (smaller than 4 ft. length) must also be bundled, easy to handle
- Old appliances
- Scrap Metal
- · Yard debris (smaller than 4ft.)
- · Passenger & light truck tires (4 max per vehicle)
- . E-Waste, computers, monitors, TV's

#### Unacceptable Items:

- · No household Garbage
- · No loose trash
- · No liquid waste, paint, or pesticides
- No large truck tires

Note: There will be no pick up of trash or recyclables that day, residents are reminded not to put out items on street, unless it is free to the public. \*\*\*NOTE to Seniors and others with physical disabilities: due to COVID-19 restrictions and company policy, Sweet Home Sanitation will not be able to pickup from your residence this year. Please make arrangements to have your items dropped off at the Rec Center. We are sorry for the inconvenience!



## Where does your Yard Debris go?

- Yard Debris Life Cycle
  - Picked up by Sweet Home truck at curb
  - Stockpiled at Sweet Home transfer station
  - Hauled in bulk to Rexius (Coburg yard)
  - Rexius grinds and screens material into 3 different qualities (fine compost, medium compost and "hog fuel")
  - They use this end product to mix with topsoil and other organic matter
