Governor Brown hosted a phone call for elected officials this afternoon. Mayors, Councilors, Senators and Representatives were on the call. Governor Brown relayed her order that will be posted tomorrow. Basically, the order and message fall around, “Stay Home, Stay Healthy” message.

Call highlights are below:

- ★ Salons, tattoo parlors, and other like personal services will be shut down.
- ★ Movie theatres and other business that require general public assembly will be shut down.
- ★ People are encouraged to only travel when necessary.
- ★ Mayors were encouraged to message around the Stay Home theme if they felt compelled to do so.
- ★ The Department of Homeland Security has issued a master list of essential businesses.
- ★ Officials were concerned about the capability of those businesses to comply with the social distancing recommendations.
- ★ The State Parks will be closed.
- ★ Brown indicated that she did not want to implement a Shelter-in-Place model. She feels it sends the wrong message and scares people.
- ★ Governor Brown did not want to start making exemption lists. Brown will issue orders as recommended by top State health advisors.
- ★ Cities are being encouraged to use social media platforms and their websites to inform the public. Governor Brown commended those efforts made by cities and counties thus far.
- ★ Brown encouraged cities and counties to post suggested family activities families to pass the time.
- ★ Stay Home, Stay Healthy.
