Mayor Ware & Council have directed Staff to come along side community partners to help Sharing Hands feed those in need. I am proud to report that our local faith community, the Calapooia Food Alliance, the Brownsville Rural Fire District, the Senior Center and the American Legion are all busy helping and sharing resources to ease the burden being felt by Sharing Hands, our local food bank.

We have developed a framework to help coordinate the efforts. The purpose of this newsletter is to share the needs and to let everyone know what is happening, how you can help and where you can go for assistance.

**Other News** | The City has struck a deal with the Linn County Clerk's Office to collect your ballots. Please drop your ballot off using City Hall's drop box located to the right of the front door. Make sure you return the ballot as directed! It is one week early. The County has instituted safety protocols for those handling all those ballots.

Mayor Ware issued an emergency declaration regarding Planning Commission submittals. Conditional Uses, Planned Unit Developments and other processes requiring an official meeting of the Planning Commission has been placed under a moratorium until the emergency declaration is lifted. Building applications and plans (acc. structures, fences, single fam. dwellings) and over-the-counter permits (mech. & plumbing) are still accepted. Public Works continues to deliver water and treat wastewater. The guys are busy moving and preparing the cemetery for Memorial Day to honor our veterans!




