OCWCOG IS OFFERING A NEW TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF DRIVERS IN OUR REGION WHO ARE INTERESTED AND OUALIFIED FOR CAREERS IN TRANSIT.

To qualify for a reimbursement for 50% of your tuition, CDL training must be completed at Linn-Benton Community College between January 1, 2024, and June 18th, 2025. In addition, after receiving your license, you will have to have added a Passenger Endorsement Permit to your CDL.
