

Marijuana Taxation



All cities allowed to tax up to three percent (3%)



The State Legislature created a separate formula from State Revenue Sharing for redistributing marijuana revenues.



To be eligible to receive revenue, a city must allow all four types of marijuana businesses:

- 1) Retailer,
- 2) Distributor,
- 3) Wholesaler &
- 4) Processor

State Redistribution formula is 17% of total revenue sent back to communities based on population, not the amount of shops & facilities.

All cities in Oregon received a portion of the initial tax revenue received from the creation of marijuana establishments. The City of Brownsville received \$6,029.93.
